

#### Ninja Fidget Spinner Materials:

- Black paper or card stock - several layers to make it thick enough to hold the coins and not bend
- Post-it notes in NEON colors
- Pennies or low-denomination coins. Alternatively, you can use buttons.
- Hot-glue gun or other glue
- Toothpick
- Scissors
- Clipper (to cut toothpick)

#### Ninja Fidget Spinner Directions:

- 1.) Pick out a shape and cut out your shape on black paper. Glue together several black layers together.
- 2.) Trace the same shape on a Post-it note of contrasting color.
- 3.) Glue the contrasting shape on the black shape.
- 4.) Use a needle to create a hole in the center of your shape. It must be big enough for the toothpick to cleanly puncture through and spin without any friction.
- 5.) Next, make two discuses (several layers of black paper cut in a circle, glued together) and puncture a hole in the center of both.
- 6.) Pierce one discus with one end of the toothpick and pierce the spinner shape with the other end of the toothpick.
- 7.) Glue your toothpick to the discus, but not the spinner. Then, add the other discus on the other end.
- 8.) Clip the toothpick so that your spinner spins freely, but not too loose.
- 9.) Glue down the other side of the toothpick to discus.
